ANTI-RAGGING COMMITTEE MEETING HELD ON Date: 11-Oct-2022,

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Discussions & Resolutions of the above cited-Agenda:

The meeting notes can be summarized as follows:

1. The Chairman welcomed all committee members, department heads, and representatives from the faculty, police, media, parents, and students.
2. Members praised the Chairman for successful anti-ragging measures during the **2022-23** academic year.
3. The committee recorded that no ragging cases were booked in **2021-22**.

Discussion details as below:

1. Review & Confirmation of the previous meeting held on Date **24-July-2021**.
The committee reviewed and confirmed ARC minutes held on **11th Oct 2022**.
2. **Discussion on Guidelines of UGC, AICTE and Supreme Court directives:**
The committee members were informed that as per guidelines of UGC, AICTE and Supreme

Court directives, the details of consequences of ragging are clearly mentioned in the prospectus.

3. Salient features of ragging prohibition in educational institutions act 26 of 1997 promulgated by A.P legislative assembly:

The Andhra Pradesh Prohibition of Ragging Act, 1997 (Act 26 of 1997) strictly bans ragging inside and outside all educational institutions. It defines clear punishments based on the severity of the act, mandates immediate student dismissal upon conviction, and holds institution heads accountable if they fail to act.

4. Constitute Anti ragging monitoring Cell involving second year students' representatives:

The committee members discussed how to set up the monitoring cell of each department involving senior faculties from each department also student representatives to prevent ragging within the institution, buses and hostel premises. This cell has to monitor continuously at designated areas mentioned in table. Also suggested to conduct anti-ragging campaigns in the form of Flexes, Posters and Boards in college premises and surrounding areas where there is a chance of ragging.

5. Duties and responsibilities of anti-ragging squad members:

The committee discussed about the role of mentors, Anti ragging squad members and faculty members to mentor the students. Also additional duties of checking prominent places such as hostels, canteen, bus and vehicle parking places, auditorium, library and etc. at regular intervals.

6. Workshop on to aware of the consequences that may arise from ragging and its liable punishment:

Then committee members suggested conducting workshop by inviting jurisdictional police officers and eminent personalities to address freshers and senior students' areas to make the campus Ragging- Free within and outside of institute.

7. Anti-ragging oath from senior students and also undertaking letter from the parents:

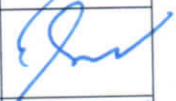
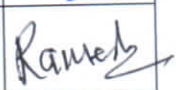
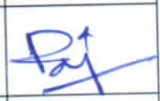
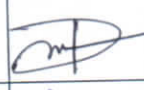
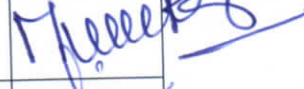
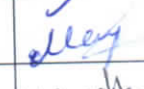
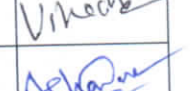
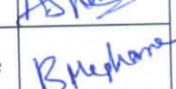
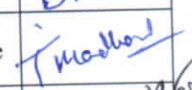
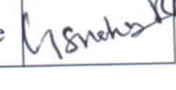
