INTRODUCTION NATIONAL ROAD SAFETY







1. Aware of each traffic sign : Various traffic signs and their meanings : **Red** light signifies "Stop". signifies " stop, watch, and be safe", it is a kind of warning that red light is about to appear soon. **Green** signifies "Go"

2. Confront the traffic :

>Always walk in such a way that we can properly see the other vehicles that are coming our way. The risk of accidents and injuries can be reduced by following this rule. Hence it is one of the essential road safety rules that a child may never forget in his life.





3. Wear a helmet :

Wear a helmet while riding bike.This will help to be safer in life.

4. Always walk on the pavement :
> Use of the pavement and not walk on the street, will be developed as a habit.
> If there is no footpath, walk on the left side margin of the road.

5. Try to cross at the zebra crossings :
➤ Crossing the street at the zebra crossing is the right way to be followed by every one of us.

6. Always look left and right :

➢Always remember the golden rule "look to the left and right of the road at a green traffic light" even though it is a one-way road.

7. Hold hands while crossing the road Hold the hands of parents, siblings or guardian while crossing the road.

8. Say no to running

Never run across or along the road. Istay calm on the road.





9. Play within boundaries : Playing beyond an explicit boundary should not be allowed.

>" No playing zones" (areas which are near to road or have heavy traffic) can be fixed. >Don't try to pick a toy or ball rolling out into the street, without any adult supervision.

10. Use bright or reflective clothes : >Helps the drivers to recognize any person in the dark. >Helps in avoiding unnecessary crashes.

11. Be safe than feel sorry :

Be extra cognizant of everything you do on the street.

Use the seat belt, whenever you enter a car.

> Do not use earphones or listen to music while riding a bicycle or driving.







ROAD ACCIDENT STATISTICS

More than 1.5 million people are killed in road accidents, worldwide, every year.

➤3 to 4 % of Gross National Product is lost in "Road Accidents".

➢ Total Annual economic loss of India due to road. accidents is more than Rs. TEN LAKH CRORES..!

➢i.e. more than TWO times the annual defense budget (Rs. 4,80,000 Crores) for FY 2021-22

> \geq 1.5 million people killed each year i.e. around 4,000 deaths daily, 600 of them are children.

 \geq 50 million people are injured in road crashes each year.
